Installing Voalte Me

To install Voalte Me on your phone, please follow these steps:

1.	iPhone users: Open the Comp Portal Android users: Go to the Work Profile and open the Play Store with a blue or orange briefcase
2.	Search for Voalte Me and click Install *Some iPhones will alert the user that the Voalte Me app is about to be installed, confirm Install. This may take a couple of minutes. App Installation Mass General Brigham is about to install and manage the app "Voalte Me" from the App Store. Your iTunes account will not be charged for this app. Cancel Install
3.	When asked to enter a Voalte Site Code, enter 'mgbmgh' VOalte me Velcome to Voalte Please enter your Voalte Site Code provided to you by an administrator. mgbmgh
4.	When prompted, ALLOW all prompts (e.g. access the microphone, send notifications, etc.)

In Settings>Notifications>Voalte Me*, make sure the following are enabled:

- Allow Notifications
- Critical Alerts (if prompted, accept Critical Alerts pop up)

Ensure the following Alerts are selected/enabled:

- Lock Screen
- Lock Notification Center
- Banners
- Banner Style Temporary
- Sounds
- Badges

You can choose to see a preview of incoming alerts and texts

- Always: Name of sender + message preview when phone is locked or unlocked
- When Unlocked: Name of sender + message preview when phone is unlocked. Sender ONLY when phone is locked
- **Never**: Only name of sender regardless of whether phone is locked or unlocked

*If you don't see Voalte Me in Settings>Notifications, go to Settings>Voalte Me>Notifications and you'll see the same settings
